The 2025 football and cheer season marks the 25th year of partnering with central Macomb County families as they support their young athletes in football and cheer competition. mer



WEATHER IMPACTS ON PRACTICE

In cases of inclement weather, alternate arrangements may be made and will be communicated by your athlete's coach or by the organization.

As the fall deepens and daylight wanes, cheer practice will be moved indoors (coaches communicate locations). Football will continue to practice outdoors.

Barring inclement weather, football practice is held outdoors. Ensure your athlete is properly attired for cooler fall weather.

FINANCIALS

Our volunteer board stewards the Mustangs' financial resources to maximize the power of every dollar that comes into the organization.

Cheerleader and football athlete **registration fees only cover approximately two-thirds (2/3) of our operating budget.**

The budget gap is closed by sponsorships and fundraising. The crucial role of fundraising cannot be overstated.

HOMECOMING RAFFLE


Our Main Fundraiser

Official Policy


Participants in the Macomb Mustangs Youth Football and Cheer Club shall be provisioned with equipment to be used during the season. Once issued, the participant's family assumes responsibility for maintaining the good condition of the equipment while in their possession. Said equipment shall be returned in good, clean condition at season's end or immediately upon demand if return is required sooner. The participant's family is obligated for paying the cost of any equipment lost, destroyed, or not returned.

To ensure return of provisioned equipment, an Equipment Deposit check of \$100 per participant shall be required at Equipment Hand-Out. No equipment will be issued without the equipment deposit.

If all equipment is returned in good, clean condition, other than what is considered normal wear, then the Equipment Deposit check shall be returned to the family at Equipment Turn-In. If equipment has not been returned in satisfactory condition, the Equipment Deposit check will be cashed by the organization. If the cost of replacement or repair exceeds the equipment deposit, the participant's family's volunteer commitment check will be cashed. If the cost of replacement or repair exceeds both the equipment and commitment deposit checks, the participant's family will be responsible for the balance to replace or repair.

The family of the participant(s) shall furnish participating child(ren) with the prescribed shoes, socks, supporter, and such other personal equipment as is necessary for their health and safety.

VOLUNTEERING IS AT OUR CORE



Every position in the Mustangs organization is filled with a passionate volunteer, from the board members to the coaches to the parents who got to the field early to make hot chocolate, coffee, and prep the concession booth on a chilly October morning.

A different game Our standard is that you volunteer at a home game other than your athlete's. That means it will be at a different time or day. Our varsity games always need volunteers.

Anyone 16+ can fill a volunteer slot on behalf of your athlete; however...

Official Policy

Participation in the Macomb Mustangs Youth Football and Cheer Club is contingent upon further participation by adults serving as organizational volunteers. Each family must fulfill **four (4) commitments per child with a max of eight (8) commitments per family.**

For the 2025 season, the Mustangs will be permitting a certain number of "commitment buyouts." You may buyout four (4) commitments for \$300.00 or eight (8) commitments for \$500.00. If you participate in the commitment buyout, you agree to the immediate cashing of either a \$300.00 (four (4) commitments) or a \$500.00 (eight (8) commitments) deposit check. Upon successful collection of those funds, you will be released from volunteer commitments for the 2025 season. The number of buyouts permitted is at the discretion of the Commitments Director and will not negatively affect the ability of the Mustangs to successfully host, manage, or maintain a safe and functional environment for all official MYFCC and/or Mustangs events. Buyouts will be issued in the order in which they were requested; if the Mustangs are unable to permit your buyout request, you will be notified and you will be required to furnish a \$300.00 commitment deposit check per our standard commitment policy, and you will be required to fulfill commitments as defined above.

Those families not participating in the commitment buyout will be required to submit a check at equipment handout for \$300.00 as a deposit to ensure volunteer commitment participation. This is a **per family** deposit. Checks will be collected at equipment handout; no equipment will be issued without the commitment deposit. The \$300.00 commitment deposit check will be cashed if commitment obligations (see above) are not fulfilled. Online commitment sign-up will only be accessible to those who submit deposit check.

GAME DAY VOLUNTEERS, CONCESSION HELPERS, and SPECIAL EVENT HELPERS, are critical to the success of our program. Game day activities include, but are not limited to: chain gang, spotters, announcer, game clock, field set-up and tear-down, merchandise, clean-up crew, security, concessions, and 50/50 raffle. Sign-up for these activities will take place once the game schedule is known and at a later date closer to the start of the season as determined by the Commitments Director. At the end of the season, your \$300.00 commitment deposit check will be returned at equipment turn-in, after confirmation of successful completion of volunteer obligations and complete return of issued equipment to the Mustangs (equipment must be in good, clean condition in order to meet this requirement).

Volunteers are obligated to appear when scheduled and remain for the entire scheduled time. If commitments are not fulfilled as required, the participant's parent/guardian authorizes the Macomb Mustangs to cash the commitment deposit check of \$300.00. Additionally, failing to meet the commitment requirement will jeopardize that participant's returning player status for the following season.
